

# eHealth in Denmark – Outside of local systems and across sectors and boundaries

## sundhed.dk and MyHealth

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The Danish eHealth portal sundhed.dk pioneers open access to medical records since 2003 and is in this regard unique worldwide. As part of the Danish Health care sector, sundhed.dk support transparency and patient empowerment and provide health professionals with the possibility to access patient health data residing outside of local systems and across sectors and boundaries. Sundhed.dk and the app MyHealth (MinSundhed) has played a crucial role during the COVID-19 pandemic in Denmark, not least due to development of the corona passport.

According to the Digital Economy and Society Index (DESI), released by the European Commission, Denmark takes a leading position in digitalization within the EU. Together with a wide variety of public, digital services sundhed.dk and MyHealth are key players in this digital position.

In this presentation I will introduce our user centered health universe sundhed.dk and MyHealth, offering access to health data for citizens and health professionals. Providing even more digital services during COVID-19 to support health authorities and the Danish citizens. Furthermore I will highlight different core elements which are fundamental to understand Digital Health in Denmark and the success of sundhed.dk and MyHealth.

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
